Day 01: Delhi - Shimla (13-14 hr)

Meal: Dinner

On arrival at Delhi Railway station you will meet taxi driver and get driven to Shimla hotel . Shimla was the former summer capital of British India, set amidst the snow-capped Shivalik Mountains. Which offers some of the most stunning views of the mighty Himalayas? On arrival at Shimla check in at the hotel and overnight stay there.

About Shimla

The British Empire may have ceased to exist, but its echo lingers on in Shimla (2205m). As the Summer Capital of the British in India, Shimla was the country's focus for the better part of every year and now, is the state capital of Himachal Pradesh. Today, it has well developed facilities, easy accessibility and numerous attractions making it one of India's most popular hill destinations. Situated in the lower ranges of the Himalayan Mountains, it is surrounded by pine deodar, oak and rhododendron forests. Towards the north lie the snow-covered high-ranges, while the valleys breathe whispering streams and swaying fields. Within the town are host of splendid colonial edifices, quaint cottages and charming walks. Shimla offers a variety of shopping, sport and entertainment activities.

<u>Day 02: Shimla – Kufri - Shimla (17 km) 40 Minutes Journey/</u> Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

Full day excursion visiting to <u>"KUFRI"</u> India's one of the best holiday paradise Kufri in Shimla is beautifully tucked on an altitude of **2,622 meter**, Via green valley, , Indira Holiday home and Fagu... and Visit JAKHU TEMPLE Evening free to stroll in the famous shopping place of Shimla town — "<u>The Mall & THE RIDGE"</u> This large open space in the heart of town presents excellent views of the mountain ranges. "· <u>CLUB HOUSE"</u> The Club House with its comprehensive facilities that include a roller skating rink, an auditorium, billiards rooms, a library, a bar and restaurant makes wonderful outing for the day." Tibetan Monastery, Van Vihar, and "<u>VASHIST</u>" Well known for its hot springs. There are old temples dedicated to the sage Vashisht and to Lord Rama. Overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 05: Manali – Solang valley (13 km) 30 Minutes /

This day visit Solang valley. In this valley you can explore ski point and adventure activities (not included). And you can see the beautiful mountain ranges of Himalayas covered with the bed of snow and lush deodar tress. In the evening back to Hotel & overnight stay there.

Solang Valley (14 kms)

Solang Nullah is in a side valley at the top of the Kullu valley. It is the site of Manali's ski school and, once the snow has gone, all the local paragliding 'schools'. Phatru is a steep, rocky face above Solang Nullah, facing roughly east. Take-off is about one hour's climb above the ski school. There is no top landing, but good bottom landing near the school or in the fields above Solang village on the opposite side of the

river. From 10am until 1 pm or so there are many excellent thermal sources. In the afternoon the sun is often hidden by cloud forming on the higher mountains behind and it can get rough as soon as it is out of direct sun. In a picture sque setting this has good ski sloped and picnic spots.

The Dalai Lama resides here. At the start of Mcleodganj is a small bazaar filled with variety of Tibetan_handicrafts and artifacts. At the end of the spur lies the Namgyal Monastery. In the evening drive back to Dalhousie overnight stay there.

<u>Day 08: Dalhousie – Khajjiar – Dalhousie (21 km) 40 Minutes /17th April,2020</u> Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

Today, we proceed to Khajjiar. Khajjiar is part of the notified Kalatop – Khajjiar sanctuary. The Monal Pheasant, a bird which was fairly common till recent times have become relatively difficult to spot nowadays but this species can be spotted here.

About Khajjiar

Often called India's Switzerland, the exquisite glade of Khajjiar (1960m) has a circumference of about 5 km. along its fringes, thick forests of deodar climb the slopes, and the snow-line rests above these

woods. At Khajjiar there is a 12th century temple dedicated to Khajji Nag. Within the temple are life size wooden images of the five Pandav brothers.
